Zachary Cheir (Year 12, Alexander)

In 2018, Zachary was Captain of the First V Basketball team and Captain of the 2018 PSA 'Blackwood Cup' Champions. His leadership and performance both on and off the court was outstanding. He played as one of the team's guards and controlled much of the ball in attack and defense.

Over the six games Zachary averaged 18 points per game with a game high of 33 points against Guildford Grammar School. He also gathered several assists, rebounds and steals in every game in which he played. Zachary was instrumental in leading the team defense, which helped stop the opposition from scoring, while created scoring opportunities for the Scotch team. Zachary played one of his best games against Wesley College, the eventual second place winner. In fairly tight contest, Zachary played an outstanding second half to help secure the win and help put one hand on the Cup as the only undefeated team left in the competition. Zachary possessed the all-round basketball game which contributed towards his outstanding performance in 2018 and helping the team win the 'Blackwood Cup' for the fourth time in Scotch College's history.

Zachary also played for the WABL under 18's First team for the Perry Lakes Hawks. He was part of the team that made the Grand Final in 2017 and was part of the Hawks' Academy Squad. In 2018, Zachary played for the 20's First team for the Perry Lakes Hawks.
